

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

4. For the best results, let the sunscreen dry for 15 minutes before sun exposure and getting wet. If the sticker turns blue before the sunscreen is applied, it will turn white again once the sunscreen dries on the sticker.
5. When the sticker turns blue during use it is a reminder that both it and the skin are now being exposed to harmful UV rays. Re-apply sunscreen to the skin following steps 3 and 4 and the sticker will turn white indicating that sunscreen protection has been restored. Repeat this step as required during the day.
6. After using the sticker for one day gently peel it off the skin and apply a new one for the next day.



Sunburn Alert stickers warn the user when sunscreen needs to be re-applied. When wearing the sticker always keep it exposed to the sun and ensure it is not covered by clothing. Sunburn Alert stickers are non-toxic and comply with the US Consumer Products Safety Improvement Act. They are not suitable for children under 3 years old and should not be applied to the face.


This product does not contain sunscreen and does not protect against sunburn. Repeated skin exposure to the sun may increase the risk of premature skin aging, skin cancer and other harmful effects of the sun even if sunburn does not occur. The use of Sunburn Alert stickers combined with limiting sun exposure, wearing appropriate clothing and the use of sunscreen may reduce the risks.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

1. The skin must be dry and free of any lotions, creams or sunscreen before applying the Sunburn Alert sticker. Apply sunscreen after the sticker is applied to the skin.
2. Peel the sticker from the backing and apply it firmly to the back of the hand. It is UV sensitive and turns blue when exposed to the sun's UV rays.
3. Apply sunscreen liberally and evenly to the skin and the Sunburn Alert sticker, following the instructions on the sunscreen packaging carefully.


